EYFS Spring 2

Communication and Language

During all sessions we will try to answer 'how' and 'why' in response to stories and events. We will also talk about and explain reasons for actions, events, activities; explain their ideas giving reasons in different context. We will continue to follow instructions, requests and ideas in a range of contexts and situations. We will also try to increase our vocabulary and use new words in the correct context.

Physical development

In P.E sessions we will learn to move in different ways such as climbing, crawling, skipping, sliding, slithering, shuffling. We will learn how to use apparatus and equipment safely. We will use equipment to move in different ways and hold balances.

Handwriting: We will continue to focus on building strength and control. We will use 'Dough Gym' and the outdoor equipment to bend, flex and rotate our fingers, elbows and wrist to help us control our pencils more effectively.

Expressive Arts and Design

This half term we will learn to how to experiment with different art processes and techniques. We will use different techniques within painting, drawing, collage and sculpture using a variety of media and materials.

We will also make models using different construction materials We will use construction kits, reclaimed materials to experiment with different ways to build, construction and join resources.

Literacy

- This half term we will continue to learn to
- Orally compose a sentence and hold it in memory before attempting to write it.
 - Recognise and know there needs to be spaces between words in a simple sentence.
 - Recognise and know that full stops are at the end of a sentence.
 - Recall the main points in text in the correct sequence.
 - Use the structure of a simple story when re-enacting and retelling.
 - Act out stories through role-play activities, using simple props (e.g. hats, masks, clothes, etc.).
 - Use phonic knowledge to attempt unknown words.

Mathematics

This half term we will continue to learn how to represent numbers in different ways. We will also start to learn our number bonds to ten. We will learn about more about measures. We will learn about length, height and time. We will also learn about shapes and their properties. We build and make pictures with 2D and 3D shapes. We will also learn about the patterns all around us.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

This half term we will be focusing on our similarities and differences. We will talk about what we like and don't like recognising that differences make us who we are. We will also discuss that we may be different but we are all important and matter. We will share our ideas and interests. We will learn to take with pride about our work and achievement. for themselves and others.

This half term we will learn more about Lent and how we can follow Jesus' example and think of others. We will learn about Jesus' life and the events leading to his resurrection on Easter Sunday.

Understanding the World

ICT: We will learn to use the internet and iPad apps to gather more research about our topics. We will also learn how to programme floor robots to navigate a course we have created.
